**Principal's Report:**

-Ian told the Council that marks for all students for this year will be determined by the marks the students had as of March 13th. Any work completed since that date cannot bring marks down, but student's work could bring these marks up. Report card deadlines for teachers have been extended a bit due to these circumstances, however Ian feels that report cards will be ready for the same time this year that they were last year.

-Ian confirmed that Luke Felhaber, a teacher currently at Pine Glen will be joining Irwin starting in September.

- All classes starting in September will be split and the grade 7 and 8's will have two split classes.

-The school is aiming for the evening of June the 24th to have a virtual grade 8 graduation. On June 25th, Ian is working on possibly having a drive along Dwight Beach Road for the graduating students to arrive at the school and have a small ceremony where Covid 19 guidelines will be followed.

-Ian reports that starting in September, there will be a total of 147 registered students at Irwin.

**Emma's Report:**

-Emma has nothing new to report since last meeting. She said that there will be another virtual meeting if new significant information comes up before the end of June. Otherwise, she said there may be a meeting at the end of the summer before school starts in September.
